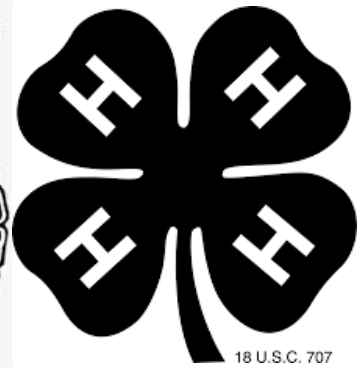

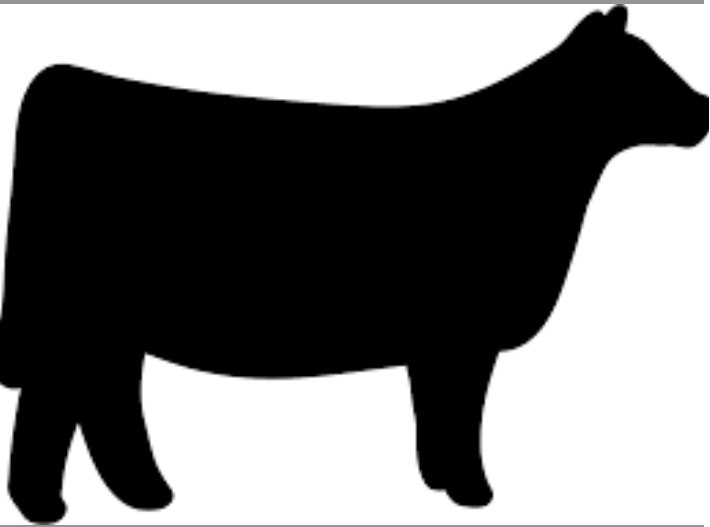

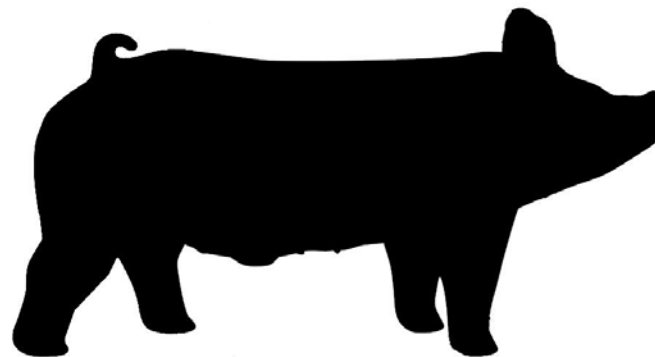
BUILDS SKILLS
